## **Chrome Os Interview Questions**

### Q1. What is Chrome OS?

**Chrome OS** is a Linux based operating system that is derived from **Chromium OS**. First **released in 2011**, and **Designed by Google**, Chrome OS mainly runs on Chromebooks, Chromeboxes, Chromebits, and Chromebases. In Chrome OS, the application and the user data mainly reside in the cloud as Chrome OS primarily runs web applications.

This operating system has an integrated media player, file manager, and support for Chrome apps that resembles the native applications. In 2014, Chrome OS started supporting Android applications. It also has support for Linux terminal and applications.

#### Q2. Enlist major features of Chrome OS?

#### Some of the major features of the Chrome OS are,

- 1. Chrome OS is a free and open-source OS.
- 2. There are no desktop applications on Chrome OS as everything is based on the cloud. That is, the Chrome OS only runs web applications using the browser.
- 3. Everything stored on the Chrome OS is on the cloud.

- 5. It is responsive and boots in seconds.
- 6. It has support for Android and Linux applications.

The supported platforms by the Chrome OS are arm, arm64, x86, x64.

#### Q4. In what programming language Chrome OS is written?

**Google Chrome OS (Operating System)** is written in C, C++, **JavaScript**, **HTML5**, and **Python** programming languages.

Chromebrew is the popular package manager in the Chrome OS.

#### Q7. What is crosh?

**Crosh** is a shell environment provided with the Chrome OS. With this command line, you can run several commands from the Chrome OS. But the Crosh shell command doesn't have the support for the majority of Linux commands.

This shell command can be accessed by just pressing **ctrl+alt+t**.

#### **Q8.** Is Chrome OS better than windows 10?

The answer to the question depends upon your work and what you do with your computer. If you are a gamer, creative worker like photo, music, video editor, programmer, then Windows will suit you as it has support for a lot of desktop applications. If you use only web apps and your work depends only on the browser like using Google docs, mail, and youtube, then Chrome OS will suit you. Chrome OS has its own advantages like faster boot time, responsiveness, more battery life, so for some people Chrome OS will be better than Windows 10.
